Urban Cycling Classes in Rancho Cordova

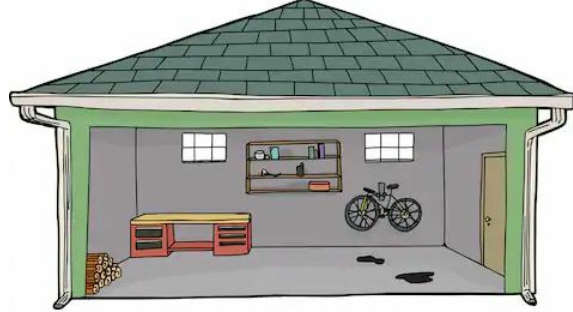
