The Bicycle Safety Stop law (AB122) was passed by the Senate Transportation Committee with a vote of 12-2. The bill is currently pending in the Senate Appropriations Committee. Let's hope it will soon pass the Committee and come to the Senate floor for a vote. Learn more about this [here](#).

Broadway Bridge Virtual Open House


