Rolling into 2022, with a return to in-person events, we've been busy spreading Bike Love by:

- **Repairing bicycles for youth and adults** in our often overlooked communities to keep them rolling.
- Serving as a lead organization in **launching a neighborhood community "fix-it" fair** in South Sacramento. We are bringing much needed bicycle services to a community who needs them and has limited access to them.
- Providing our known and **loved Bike Valet service** so that people can ride to an event and be assured that their bicycle will be waiting for them so they can ride home.
- Expanding our program that **matches bicycles in good repair to people who need a bicycle** for daily use and travel.
- Launching a **bicycle intern program** to teach youth basic bike mechanic skills so that they can work on the bikes in their home communities.
- Launching a **bicycle registration program** to help stop bike theft and support recovery in the event of a theft.
- Co-hosting a **bicycling instructor education class** which allows us to hold more classes to build cycling confidence and skills.
- **Hosting May is Bike Month** for these six Norcal regions: Sacramento, Yolo, Yuba, Sutter, Placer and El Dorado counties.

We also focused in on advocating for the implementation of climate recommendations related to active transportation, equity, and safety, in the City's Transportation Priorities Plan and Climate Plan.

Simply put, **we believe in the power of the bicycle.**

And if you believe in it too, we ask you to ***help us reach our goal of \$10,000*** which will be used to strengthen and expand all of the program areas
