

Transit Style Bikeway Map: Sacramento

SABA is redefining the way people bike around Sacramento with the development of a new bikeway connections map and the current version is ready for feedback! This work was inspired by Michael Graham's very cool spider maps which you can read about here.

Most bike maps are chockfull of information, which makes them a bit hard to process. Our map highlights key bike routes and connections in and around Sacramento following low-stress routes utilizing a mix of Class I, II, III, and IV bike routes. Additional resources include bike/ped crossings of highways, interstates, and water or land features. Blue and gold light rail lines with stations are provided.

This is not intended to be a comprehensive list of every low-stress road but rather prioritize those supportive to new riders, are direct, and avoid frequent road changes. Also, it's easy to discover where we need more infrastructure. We think this could be a cool resource for folks and we hope you think so too. Feedback is
