Levee work on American & Sacramento Rivers



Did you know that it's possible that we'll experience a 100-year flood within the next 40 years? Given how high the rivers were this winter, that seems plausible and it would be catastrophic if it happened. That's why the Army Corps of Engineers is doing extensive levee repair work along the American and Sacramento Rivers. This means that there will be closures on both rivers over the next 6-8 months. Detours with good signage will be along the levees and closures. Think of it as longterm safety for all of us.
