City of Sacramento needs your input on the draft "Sacramento 2040" plans

For the first time, environmental justice is a key consideration in the City of Sacramento's general plan update.

The City of Sacramento is hosting a **self-guided online workshop** for community members to review and comment on the draft "Sacramento 2040" plans, which is the City's blueprint for how and where it will grow over the next 20 years and the framework to guide Sacramento's efforts to mitigate and adapt to climate change.



The General Plan contains policies that guide transportation investments, housing development, historic preservation, public safety, economic development, equity and environmental justice, environmental protection, and more.

The Climate Action & Adaptation Plan includes measures and actions to reduce greenhouse gas emissions, strategies for adapting to the projected impacts of climate change, and a path to reach carbon neutrality by 2045.

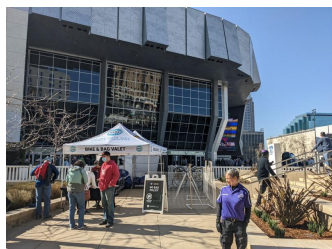

BikU Competition Winners

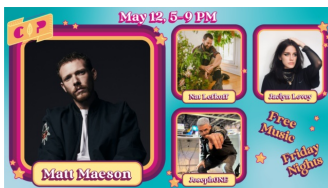
