SAClovia: Bikes on Del Paso Blvd.

Sacramento Area Bicycle Advocates (SABA) will be hosting **SAClovia** on Del Paso Boulevard between Hawthorne and Fairfield Streets on **Sunday, May 28, 2023**. There will be various local vendors present including food, music, yoga, bike shows, and live mural painting from **11:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.**

SAClovia is an open streets event. Inspired by La Ciclovía, Spanish for the cycleway, a tradition in Bogota, Columbia which shuts down streets and highways to cars temporarily to allow residents and shoppers the opportunity to explore an area of their city using a form of active transportation, such as cycling.

The event is **free** to the public.

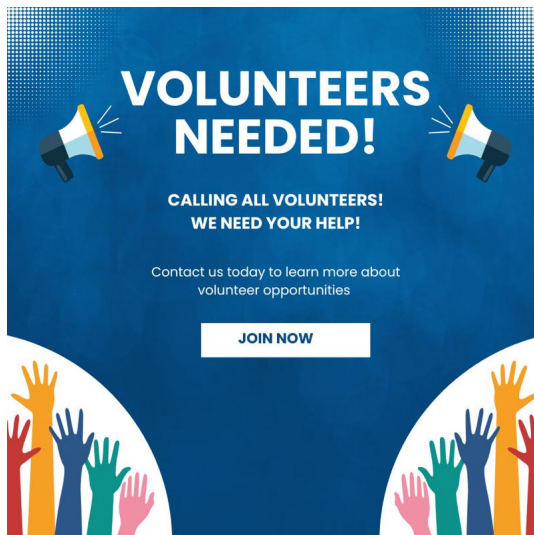
