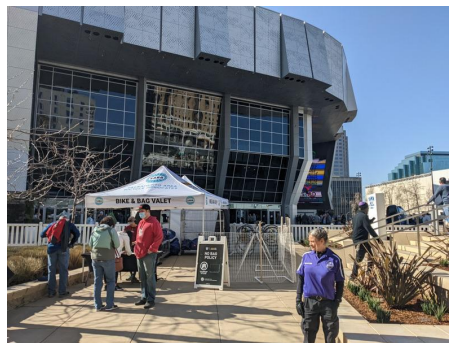
Preserve the American River

Protect Our River, Protect Our Future!

Join us and our partners the Sierra Club, and SARA (Save the American River Association) to prevent the Trumark Corporation from filling 20 acres of the American River designated floodway directly adjacent to the Parkway with their proposal for dense housing. Developing housing in this area would be detrimental to urban forests and wildlife in the area. It will also severely restrict access to the parkway for hikers, cyclists, and nature lovers.

We are located **J and 9th**

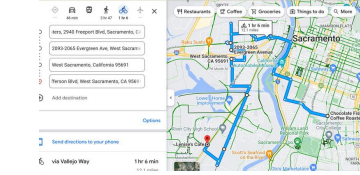
Services **open at 4:30 p.m. and close at 9:30 p.m.** We stop accepting bikes at **8:30 p.m.**
