### **City Council Meeting on ATC**

For the second week in a row, our city council is set to make decisions that will have a lasting impact on our city's biking and infrastructure. Our Active Transportation commission will present their eight recommendations at

Tuesday's meeting on August 29, 2023. SABA discussed those recommendations in detail on our social media channels, and in a blog post on our website that can be found <u>here</u>. Overall, what really matters more than anything for those participating is to strongly encourage our city council to provide funding for active transportation immediately.

The city council meeting will take place at City Hall Council Chamber – 915 I Street, 1st Floor, Sacramento, CA 95814 at 5:00 p.m Tuesday. For those attending via zoom, the credentials for the meeting are Meeting ID:983 1698 1872 and password:802467. The ATC's presentation is item #11 of the Agenda. Written comments can be left on the city's official website using eComment. While written comments aren't read aloud, they will be distributed to all members and filed on record.

If you plan to speak at the meeting, we encourage you to rehearse your comments beforehand. Each speaker is only given two minutes to speak, which is enforced by a countdown timer. The average person speaks anywhere from 100–150 words per minute. We suggest crafting a statement that is 250 words or less to ensure you meet the time allotted.
