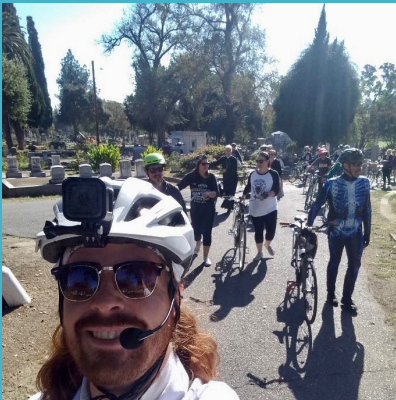


SABA Bike Mechanics get Recognized
