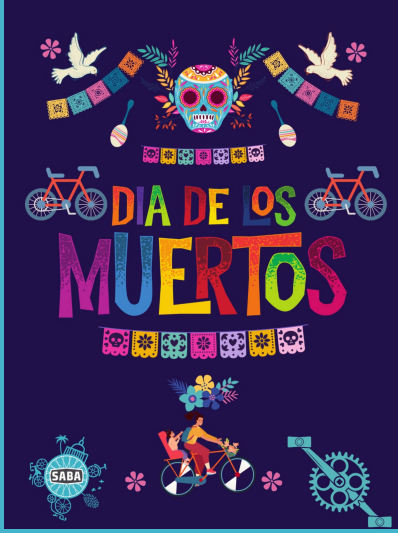


Dia De Los Muertos Ride
