Cycling in the News

- <u>Governor Newsom Signs SB 960, the Complete Streets Bill</u>, *CalBike* The Complete Streets Bill will require Caltrans to consider the needs of people riding bikes, walking, and taking transit on our state roadways, many of which serve as local streets.
- What does transportation justice look like?. The Oaklandside Maintaining the transportation status quo in our cities is inequitable and untenable in every way — economically, environmentally and socially. That's the blunt assessment of a new "mobility justice" report from the Anti-Police-Terror Project, an Oakland-based nonprofit.
- Bike lanes don't just benefit cyclists, Commonwealth Beacon A

comprehensive study by the University of Colorado Denver and the University of New Mexico found that bike lanes benefit the entire city by enhancing safety and accessibility, improving traffic flow, and promoting environmental sustainability.
