#### Cycling and Public Transportation in the News

- SacRT to introduce new fare payment system and discount fare program for veterans in 2025, Mass Transit, November 11: In partnership with the California Department of Technology and the California Integrated Travel Project, the six-month pilot program will provide discount fares for up to 60,000 eligible military veterans residing in the Sacramento, CA region.
- Why widening highways doesn't reduce traffic congestion, Yale Climate Connections, October 18, 2024: Communities throughout California continue to invest heavily in highway expansion projects that undermine efforts to change how people get around.
- <u>California youth launch California High School Transit Alliance to take on transit issues</u>, *Mass Transit*, November 20: CalHSTA will help bring public transit issues directly to students, with a focus on supportive in-school and out-of-school meetings and activities at individual campuses.
