California Launches its First Statewide E-bike Voucher Project



California is launching a new incentive on Dec. 18 that will provide income-eligible Californians up to \$2,000 toward the purchase of a new e-bike - the latest example of how the state is expanding access to zero-emissions transportation options to residents who need the boost the most.

The California E-bike Incentive Project is being launched in partnership with more than 20

community-based organizations that will do outreach and provide application assistance. Once approved, <u>income-eligible individuals</u> can redeem the voucher from <u>retailers</u> at the point of purchase. A rider safety video is provided and required before collecting the voucher.

Cycling and Public Transportation in the News

- Sacramento didn't invest much in road safety. It paid \$21 million for car crash lawsuits, by Ariane Lange, Sacramento Bee, December 2: Sacramento officials agreed to pay \$21 million in settlements after vehicle crashes on city streets from 2019 through 2023, a span during which the Department of Public Works repeatedly told the City Council that it lacked enough funding to achieve the council's goals.
- <u>Bike-Friendly Candidates Elected in California Races</u>, by Jared Sanchez, CalBike, November 13: CalBike endorsed eight candidates for the state legislature and one bike champion in a county race. Six of those nine candidates won their races, one lost, and two are still too close to call.
