## **You Can Also Donate a Bike**

In December, SABA is providing free bicycles, helmets, lights and locks to students at Katherine Johnson Middle

School (where 85% of the students are economically disadvantaged) in Arden Highlands in Sacramento.

We are looking for donations of girls and boys bikes with 20 and 24 inch wheel sizes. (Sizes can be found on the side of the tire). Bikes should be in good working condition or just needing minor repairs (like flat tires, brake adjustment). They should be free of rust and major damage to the paint. Please remove all training wheels if possible but we will still accept them if you cannot.
