

#### Franklin Boulevard Complete Streets Project

Construction is beginning on the <u>Franklin</u> <u>Boulevard Complete Streets Project</u>.


The project will enhance safety and provide a pedestrian, bicycle, vehicular, and transit friendly environment through improved roadway and streetscape designs.

Currently, Franklin Boulevard is a four-lane arterial with limited pedestrian and bicycle amenities, making it a less than an ideal environment for anyone traveling without a car. The final design improves connectivity for all users, improves pedestrian safety and access to businesses, creates safer traffic movements, and new bicycle routes.

Construction starts on Monday, July 28, 2025. To provide crews with safe working space, Franklin Boulevard will be reduced to one lane in each direction.

Residents and businesses will have access to their properties. The community should follow posted detours and plan for delays when traveling through the construction area.
