Half the funds raised would go to improving public transportation and half would go to improving cycling and pedestrian infrastructure, particularly in sections of Sacramento



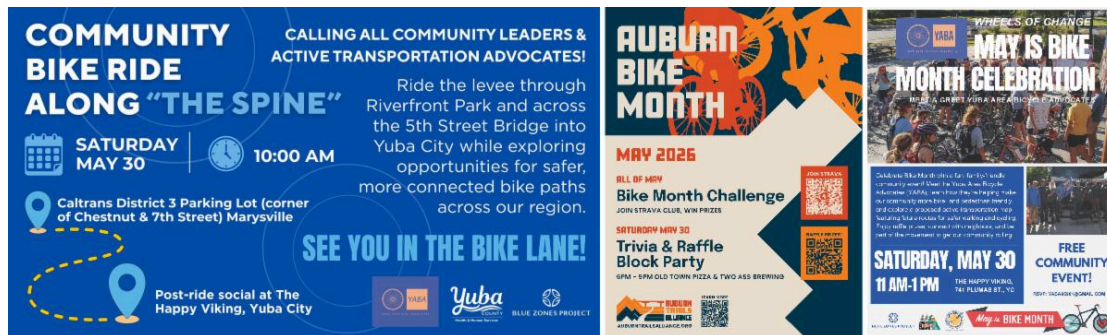
that need it the most.

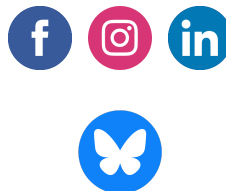
